



## Richard K. McClain

July 25, 1944 - January 14, 2017

Richard K. McClain, of Point Marion, died January 14, 2017 at Uniontown Hospital following a brief illness. Born July 25, 1944, in Morgantown, he was preceded in death by his parents, Howard and Mildred (Dils) McClain.

A 1962 graduate of Albert Gallatin High School, Richard joined the U.S. Air Force, where he achieved the rank of Airman First Class during the Vietnam Conflict. After his honorable discharge, he was employed at National Airport in Washington, DC for Northeast Airlines, and then at Houze Glass in Point Marion as a commercial artist. He then attended West Virginia University, received a degree in Landscape Architecture, and began his 40 year career in landscape design and construction. He was first a partner in Landscape Planners, Ltd., in Morgantown, and later was sole proprietor of Kendall Landscaping in Point Marion, until his passing.

He is survived by one son, Ryan Scott McClain of Scottsdale, Arizona and his fiancé, Paula Scott; a sister Diane Watson and husband Harold "Pete" of Point Marion; five nephews Grant Watson and wife Regina and their son Gabriel of Morgantown, West Virginia, Keith Watson of Point Marion; Robert and Jeffrey McClain of Shreveport, Louisiana and William McClain of Bogue Chitto, Louisiana; and by several cousins. Also left to mourn him is his former wife, Suzanne McClain of Morgantown, and special friends Marcia and Brent Romine and Mary Jo Uphold.

Also deceased is one brother, Robert McClain.

The family will receive friends in the Richard R. Herod Funeral Home, Point Marion, on Wednesday from 1 – 4 P.M. Private interment will be in Evergreen Memorial Park, Point Marion.
