Robert L. Butterworth, Sr., 87, of Point Marion, Pa., passed away unexpectedly Friday, May 6, 2022 at his home. Born near Greensburg, Pa. on Dec. 23, 1934, he was a son of the late Susanna (Anderson) and George Butterworth, Sr.

Following his graduation in 1953 from the Point Marion High School, Bob served his country in the U.S. Air Force during the Korean Conflict. Over the years, he served his community in a number of ways. He is currently the oldest member of the Point Marion Volunteer Fire Dept., joining in 1960; a former member and past president of Boro Council; had served as a boy scout leader; coach of local little league softball team; member and former lay leader at the Point Marion United Methodist Church; remained active in the Fire Department Golf League; and was a current officer in the Point Marion American Legion. He retired in 1989 from PennDOT, where he was a skilled technician in the survey department.

Surviving is his loving wife of 65 years, Patricia (Lenkowich) Butterworth; three children and their spouses, Robert and Kathy Butterworth, Jr., of Point Marion, Cynthia (Butterworth) and Steven Mehok of Mims, Florida, and Kimberly and Michael Moody of Point Marion.
