



## Robert V. Lilley

May 16, 1917 - September 5, 2008

Robert V. Lilley, 91, of Uniontown, Pa, and formerly Gaithersburg, Maryland and the Point Marion, Pa. area, died Monday, September 1, 2008, in the UPMC-Presbyterian Hospital in Pittsburgh. Born May 16, 1917 in Uniontown, he was a son of the late Andrew J. and Julia Lucas Lilley. A graduate of German Township High School, Bob served with distinction in the U.S. Navy during both World War II and the Korean Conflict, and was proud of his service and his country. He was a Deacon and member of the Administrative Board for the Rockville Christian Church, and worked for a while as consulting engineer for the U.S. Postal Service. Later, Bob was project manager for a number of large construction projects. At his retirement, he was working for United Artists supervising the building of movie sets. He was well known for his skill and talent in handcrafting furniture which he enjoyed building in his spare time. Surviving are his wife of 54 years, Jacqueline Mosako Lilley, who he married Dec. 24, 1953, a daughter, Lisa L. Lilley of Damascus, MD, and her three sons, Gary Simpson of Gaithersburg, and Spencer Simpson, of Jacksonville, FL, who were both raised by Bob in his home, and Nelson Craun of Damascus, a son, Monty Lilley of Uniontown, and his two daughters, Heather Berrien of Wake Forest, NC, and Tina Embrey of Mt. Airy, MD, and a sister, Dorothy Stein of Las Vegas, NV, and her two sons, Stuart and David. The family will receive friends at the Richard R. Herod Funeral Home, Point Marion, on Wednesday from 7 – 9 p.m., Thursday from 2 – 4 and 7 – 9 p.m., and Friday, September 5, 2008, until 11:00 a.m., the hour of service, with Rev.

David Chisham officiating. Interment follows in Little Arlington Section of Evergreen Memorial Park, Point Marion, with military rites accorded at the graveside by the Point Marion Veterans Posts.
