Ronald K. "Crowdad" Crow, 72, passed away Tuesday, July 12, 2016, at his home, following a brief illness. He was born in Morgantown, W. Va. on May 29, 1944, a son of the late Karl and Mattie (Porter) Crow.

A 1962 graduate of Albert Gallatin High School, Ron was a coal miner for 35 years, having worked for many years at the Dillworth Mine, and retiring from the Enlow Fork Mine. He was a member of the Point Marion United Methodist Church, F.O.E. #1932, UMWA, and an honorary member of the Point Marion Vol. Fire Dept.

He was an avid fan of the Pirates and the Steelers, and enjoyed being in the woods, hunting and fishing with his son.

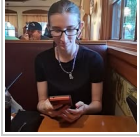
