Rose Marie Vincent Loring, 90, of New Geneva, Pa, formerly of Cassville, WV passed away peacefully Oct. 8, 2020 from this world into the arms of her Lord and Savior surrounded by her loving family. She was born April 8, 1930 in Montana Mines, WV to the late Clinton “Sparky” and M. Madeline Vincent. Rose battled with Dementia for several years.
