



## Rowena F. Bowers

August 25, 1921 - June 1, 2011

Rowena Fullmer Bowers, 89, a lifelong resident of Point Marion, Pa., passed away peacefully early Saturday, May 28, 2011. Born in Point Marion, on August 25, 1921, she was the daughter of Henry E. and Jean Laing Fullmer. Her husband of 56 years, Frank L. Bowers, Jr. passed away on May 2, 1996. Also deceased are her parents and three brothers, Warren Fullmer, Keith Fullmer and Ralph Fullmer. A 1939 graduate of Point Marion High School, Rowena was a faithful member of the Point Marion Christian Church, the Point Marion Progress Club, and the Point Marion Civic Organization.
