Scott E. Eckles, 47, of Point Marion, Pa., passed away Wednesday, August 29, 2018 at his home, following a lengthy illness. Born in Morgantown, W.Va., on April 26, 1971, he was a son of Wilma (Stewart) and Charles Lincoln, of Lake Lynn, Pa.

A graduate of Tri-Valley High School (Albert Gallatin) where he was the Salutatorian of the Class of 1989, he honorably served in the U.S. Marine Corps for six years, and was active during the Desert Storm operation in the Persian Gulf. He had worked as a maintenance technician at the Fort Martin Power Plant at Point Marion. Scott was proud of his military service, but his passion was being out in the open air, riding his motorcycles.

In addition to his loving parents, he is survived by one brother, Justin Lincoln and wife Meghan, and their daughter, his special little niece, Alexa; a half-sister, Cathi Eckles of Beaver Falls and her two children, Julianna and Sebastian Dwire; and many friends.
