Shawn Allen Nicola, 25, of Point Marion, Pa., died Tuesday, October 3, 2017 as the result of a truck accident near Clarksburg, W.Va. Born in Morgantown on June 3, 1992, he was a son of Taresa Newman Nicola of Point Marion, and Carl Nicola, Jr. of Adah.

Shawn was a 2010 graduate of Albert Gallatin High School, where he was a proud member of the JROTC and achieved the rank of Captain in the Corps. He also enjoyed music, and for all four years was a member of the trombone section of the Colonial Marching Band. Following graduation, he served for a period of time in the U.S. Army, having been discharged as a Private First Class, and was currently employed as a truck driver for Ransom Drilling.

In addition to his loving mother and father, he is survived by a brother, Jeffery Nicola of Point Marion; sisters, Jamie Roberts of Cardale and Karissa Nicola of Allison; his grandparents, David and Beverly Newman of Point Marion and Betty Nicola of Adah; aunts and uncles, David and Pamela Newman of Hagerstown, MD, and George and Carla Barrett of Ralph; and by a number of extended family and many friends.

His paternal grandfather, Carl Nicola, Sr. is deceased.

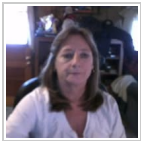
