Shirley B. Evans, 91, of Point Marion, Pa., passed away Thursday, May 9, 2024, in the Uniontown Hospital, following a brief illness. Born in Gastonville, Pa. on June 17, 1932, she was a daughter of the late Frank and Edith (Derryberry) Bowers Moser.

A 1950 graduate of Morgantown High School, Shirley had worked as a teacher's aide at Friendship Hill Elementary School, and later was the gift shop manager at Ruby Memorial Hospital in Morgantown.
