Thomas “Tommy” Brian Huggins, Jr., 33 of Dilliner, Pa., died unexpectedly Sunday, May 6, 2018 at the Ruby Memorial Hospital. Born in Morgantown on Nov. 29, 1984, he was a son of Thomas Brian Huggins, Sr., of Dilliner, and Amanda Cline of Moatsville, WV.

A 2003 graduate of Mapletown High School, he also graduated from ITT Tech in 2006 with an Associates Degree in drafting. He was a member of the First Baptist Church of Dunkard, and was faithfully attending the Beth Haven Baptist Church. He was an avid hunter and fisherman, but coon hunting was his passion. Tommy was a member of the Greene County Coonhunters, and the West Virginia Coonhunters Assoc. in Marshville, WV.
