Verna (Wozniak) Cullen, 89, of Point Marion, Pa., passed away Monday, August 21, 2017 in The Madison Center in Morgantown. Born Jan. 5, 1928, she was raised in Bobtown, Pa., a daughter of the late Martin and Rosalie (Hebel) Wozniak.

A 1945 graduate of Point Marion High School, she worked for many years as a Cafeteria Manager in the Albert Gallatin School District, retiring in 1998.
