William H. Sicklesmith, 69, of Republic, Pa., and formerly of the Greensboro, Pa. area, died Wednesday, November 26, 2013 at the VA Hospital in Pittsburgh. Born in Monongahela Township on Aug. 12, 1944, he was a son of the late William and Ellen (Gregory) Sicklesmith. A 1964 graduate of Mapletown High School, he was a U.S. Army veteran of the Vietnam Conflict. Bill was a proud member of the U.M.W.A., and he retired in 1999 from the Aloe Mine, after over 20 years in the coal mines.
